

Installation Instructions

Colonial Latch (& Twisted)

1. Position gate latch on gate to assess correct positioning. The round ring handles are positioned on the gate while the holder and guide are positioned on the fence post.
2. Drill a hole through the gate 12mm in diameter. Hole must be at least 40mm from edge of gate to accommodate decorative skirting of ring grip handle.
3. Position the long arm latch handle on gate and fasten using a No.2 Phillips bit at 1,000 RPM and self-drill screws provided (alternatively you can use a standard screwdriver). Mark holes for screws, drill 2.5mm pilot holes and fasten using screws provided and a Phillips head screwdriver.
4. Repeat this step attaching the other ring handle on the other side of the gate. Before attaching ring handle to gate, insert spindle into both handles.
5. Slide "D" shaped guide into position on locking shaft and attach using screws provided. The "D" section should be positioned on the 50mm bevelled section of the shaft.
6. Finally, attach locking section to post.
