 The second setting fully extends the bolts for thicker lambs.
- Heavy duty 1.6mm thick strikes with a radius leading edge for smoother latch operation.
- Two strikes supplied to suit Left or right hand opening doors.
- Sealed Lock case to prevent debris and saw dust from entering the lock body.
- Includes strike dust box for optional use.










ROLLER MORTISE LOCK WITH 60mm BACKSET


- You will need to determine the handing of the door so that you use the correct striker template.
- Refer to the "HANDING DIAGRAM" to determine the handing of your door.
- To hand your mortise lock to suit your requited installation. Lift the 'gravity stop' and press the latch in behind the face plate and rotate 180 degrees. This will change the direction of the latch face to suit your door handing refer DIAGRAM 1.
- Nb: The stoped edge of the latch faces towards the door jamb that will accommodable the strike.









MORTISE LOCK WITH 45mm BACKSET
