

Installation Instructions

Colonial Latch (& Twisted)

- 1. Position gate latch on gate to assess correct positioning. The round ring handles are positioned on the gate while the holder and guide are positioned on the fence post.
- 2. Drill a hole through the gate 12mm in diameter. Hole must be at least 40mm from edge of gate to accommodate decorative skirting of ring grip handle.
- 3. Position the long arm latch handle on gate and fasten using a No.2 Phillips bit at 1,000 RPM and self-drill screws provided (alternatively you can use a standard screwdriver). Mark holes for screws, drill 2.5mm pilot holes and fasten using screws provided and a Phillips head screwdriver.
- 4. Repeat this step attaching the other ring handle on the other side of the gate. Before attaching ring handle to gate, insert spindle into both handles.
- 5. Slide "D" shaped guide into position on locking shaft and attach using screws provided. The "D" section should be positioned on the 50mm bevelled section of the shaft.
- 6. Finally, attach locking section to post.
